Through the use of WYFI, we have had the opportunity to catch medication errors, dosage errors, drug-drug interactions, and lab values needed for correct medication dosages. We have also been able to account for medication discrepancies between physicians when a patient has multiple providers. We would love to see pharmacy have a role as a key player on the healthcare team. Many health conditions can be overseen in the pharmacy, as patients see their pharmacist an average of 35 times a year compared to seeing their primary care provider roughly 3 times a year. When patients are taking their medications correctly, their health conditions tend to be managed more appropriately and in turn, patients


