"The Health Information Exchange (HIE) has been, in some ways, a long time coming for this physician. Finally though, the Wyoming Frontier Information (WYFI) started making those crucial first connections in the last year. I wanted to jump in early and get my feet wet but like any new project or activity... it can take some time to reach critical mass. I am happy to report that I think we are reaching a critical mass for connectivity and having actual real-life, medical data at our fingertips!

In Powell, we have patients from different towns in the basin area use our clinic and likewise, have patients use different hospitals. A fair share of my patients use West Park Hospital in Cody. Through the WYFI HIE, I am one click away from accessing my patient records from this unaffiliated hospital 20 miles away. I can now get on and download ER reports, labs, and radiology studies...very helpful for patients who may have used the ER overnight, etc. Likewise, I also had a patient move to our area from Cheyenne and I was able to, in one click, reach back in to the CRMC record and download his recent labs and notes right there during our visit.
