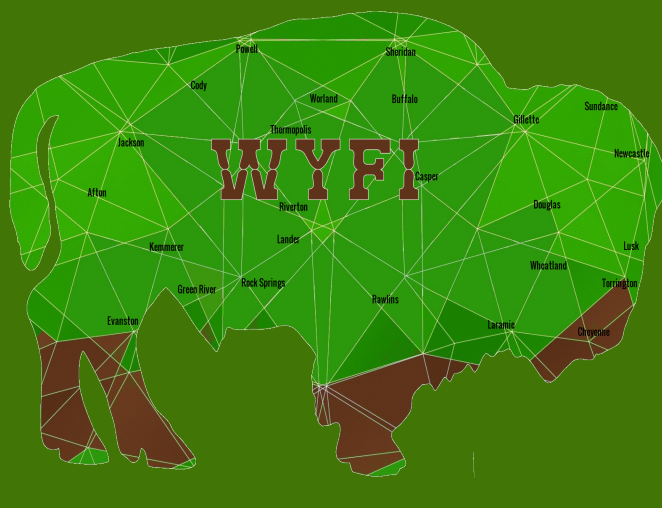

WHAT'S GOING ON WITH WYFI?

- In times of disasters or pandemic patients may be seen at facilities other than their normal primary care practice. First responders, urgent care facilities, emergency rooms and providers need a comprehensive view of patient data from all sources. The most effective method of providing that comprehensive view is through an HIE such as WYFI. WYFI can aggregate patient data from multiple sources and provide the view that health care staff need to effectively treat patients and support their transition back to their regular primary care physician.

Instant WYFI access training for your practice can be done remotely in **less than an hour**. Please know that we are here to help as we work together to fight this virus.

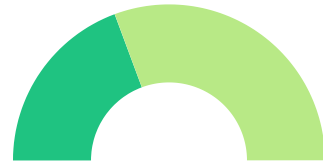

Patient Tracking

Get real-time alerts of your patients' admissions, discharges, and transfers



External Orders and Data

Access Access procedures, labs, radiology scans done outside your practice



Referrals

Send and receive referrals to support continuity of care for your patients



Community Health Record

View a longitudinal health record for your patients



Direct Messaging

Send secure messages between providers to exchange clinical data

Move In Model

In less than two weeks, you can be connected to WYFI. With competing priorities and scarce resources, another project can seem daunting. To help minimize the impact on providers, WDH is offering its Move In Model to reduce the implementation effort to connect to WYFI. Funding Opportunities

For a limited time, WDH is reimbursing providers to help offset the costs of connecting your EHR to the WYFI. Contact WYFI for more information on how to receive funding assistance.



PCMH Connectivity Requirement

As a reminder, if you are a Medicaid Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH), your clinic will be required to establish bi-directional exchange with WYFI by 2021 to maintain your PCMH status.

Regional and National Connections

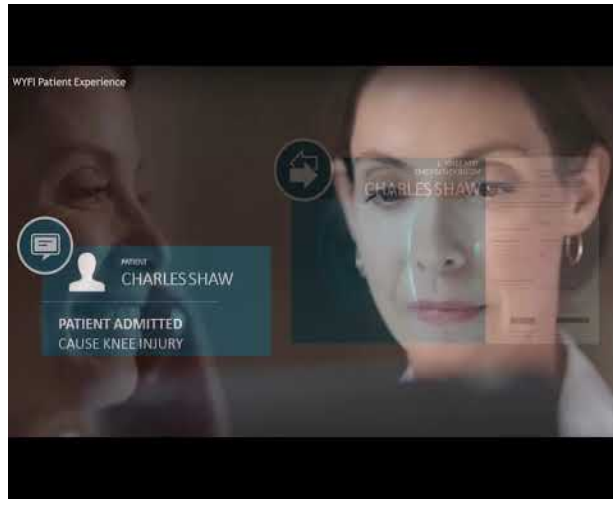
WYFI is actively building its connection with the Colorado Regional Health Information Organization (CORHIO) and is starting work with Utah Health Information Network (UHIN).
