CHR has been updated as of 3/1/2022



The Community Health Record (CHR) has been upgraded as of 3/01/2022. There are two noticeable changes that were made. The first change was to include the New - Multi-factor Authentication, and the second change was to the Patient Summary screen looking very different with drop-down options for all summaries (Medication Orders, Care Summaries, Problems/Conditions, Reports, Results, Allergies, Procedures). **If you have any questions please contact the WYFI team at wdh-wyfi-hie@wyo.gov**
