**ATTENTION Update on Meetings Scheduled:** Hospitals 🍌

The WYFI and Vital Statistics Services (VSS) teams are gearing up to get a virtual meeting scheduled with Hospitals Starting in July 2023. We will have 3 dates available so that we are ensuring that all the hospitals are able to participate in one of the meetings. The meeting's intent is to discuss where hospitals are with the FHIR upgrade in order to be able to submit Death and birth records to VSS.

The Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources' (FHIR) standard is a set of rules and specifications for exchanging electronic healthcare data. The goal is to enable the seamless and secure exchange of healthcare information so that patients can receive the best possible care.

The Wyoming Frontier Information (WYFI) makes it easier for medical care teams throughout Wyoming to securely share clinical information between institutions and practices. Services work together to bridge different facilities and providers throughout the state. Doctors, nurses, pharmacists and other healthcare professionals all have the access to the same updated clinical information to ultimately take the best possible care of Wyoming patients.

### **Community Health Record (CHR)**

The Community Health Record (CHR) provides access to a patient's clinical records from all WYFI data sources, including laboratory results, radiology reports, transcribed reports, medications and clinical care summaries. It provides streamlined, 24/7 access to a patient's clinical information within WYFI for providers and their staff. Allows care teams treating a patient to access clinical information that may not be readily available. Reduces the need to call providers to search for clinical information.

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## Why WYFI?



### Patient Tracking

Get real-time alerts of your patients' admissions, discharges, and transfers



### External Orders and Data

Access transcriptions, labs, procedures, and radiology scans done outside your practice



### Referrals

Send and receive referrals to support continuity of care for your patients



### Community Health Record

View a longitudinal health record for your patients



### Direct Messaging

Send secure messages between providers to exchange clinical data
